A **collective community kitchen** is a place where individuals can gather to pre- pare meals, both for themselves and for their families.

Shared use kitchens are licensed commercial spaces that

provide a pathway for food entrepreneurs.

A **licensed kitchen** is an inspected, registered commercial kitchen where foods intended for sale can be safely made, in accordance with laws and regulations.
